AWARDS RULES



Rules and Regulations Governing the Docklands Business Awards To be held at the Gibson Hotel, Thursday, 28th November, 2013

1. Nominee companies and organisations must be members of the Dockland Business Forum.
2. Nominee companies and organisations must be located in or do business in the Docklands area and its hinterland as defined by the Dublin Docklands Development Authority.
3. Nominating a company and organisation is free for members of the Docklands Business Forum.
4. Nominating a company and organisation is open to any Docklands Company or Organisation that are not members of the Forum on payment of a fee of €100 for companies with 1 to 49 employees, €200 for companies with 50 to 300 employees and €350 for companies with over 300 employees. A nominating company or organisation is given free membership of the Forum on payment of the nominating fee.
5. Nomination Forms must be completed and returned by 4pm on Friday, 1st November.
6. Multiple nominations are permitted and welcome.
7. It is the responsibility of the nominator to provide all the necessary information for the judges to make their decision.
8. All nominees must accept their nomination in writing/email.
9. The Docklands Business Awards Organising Committee will agree on a short list of not more than four nominations in each category.
10. One Award, Business Forum Member Award will be voted on by member organisations of the Forum on the basis of one organisation one vote.
11. The decisions of the Organising Committee and Steering Committee are final. By nominating or accepting a nomination a company, organisation or individual agrees to abide by the decision of the Organising Committee and the Steering Committee.
12. The Lifetime Achievement Award will be solely at the discretion of Steering Committee.
